

Admission Requirements for the Bachelor and Master International Business

All applicants have to provide proof of sufficient command of English language. This proof has to be submitted within the application period.

The following certificates are accepted:

- **CPE** (Certificate of Proficiency in English), all levels
- **CAE** (Certificate in Advanced English), all levels
- **TOEFL** (Test of English as an Foreign Language), Paper Test 580 points, Computer Test 237 points, Internet Test 96 points
- **BEC Higher** (Business English Certificate), all levels
- **IELTS** (International English Language Testing System), level 6-9
- **TOEIC** (Test of English for International Communication), 800 points

Furthermore all language certificates are accepted, which refer to the language proficiency of Level C1 or C2 of the Common European Framework of Reference.

Also equivalent are:

- proof of a study in English abroad of a minimum of one year and proven 60 ECTS credits
- proof of a school attendance with English as the only language of teaching in the last two years before finishing the secondary school

NOT ACCEPTED:

- Abiturzeugnis (German University Entrance Examination)
- Certificates below the level C1 (z.B. B1, B2, etc.)
- Certificates without a level
- Certificates of a study of languages at a university without a level
- Reference letters of employers
- Au-Pair-Certificates
- Work and Travel Certificates
- Proof of attendance of a High-School without High-School-Diploma
- Proof over the registration for the English Test
- Proof of attendance of a English course without graduation
- Grade transcript over a study abroad with less than 60 ECTS credits
